The tavern will be tenanted by Tenfold Investments. Director of Tenfold Investments, David Strom, said “The Brook will be similar in style to the company's other business, The Gate Bar and Bistro in Success. The design is modern Australian with an extensive garden area, bistro, sports lounge bar with Pubtab facilities and alfresco dining. The business will become an important part of the social fabric of the Ellenbrook and surrounding districts.”

The Brook will provide around 70 jobs for the Ellenbrook and neighbouring districts.

It will be an iconic establishment that the owners are sure will succeed in filling a niche in food and beverage offering catering for the residents of Ellenbrook and other neighbouring suburbs.

The exterior building aesthetic harmonises well within the existing Ellenbrook streetscape utilising extensive use of glazing, stone, tile and specialised render finishes. Generously wide awnings and canopies are also featured. Internally, cosmopolitan/contemporary finishes and furnishings have been designed to reflect / portray a stylish and relaxed atmosphere. “

Vic Evans, Managing Director of the Insurance Commission of Western Australia said “We are extremely pleased to announce the appointment of Badge Constructions as builder of the Ellenbrook Tavern and again our apologise that it has taken so long to build.”

Furthermore Mr Evans advised that “Stage 2 of the shopping centre received development approval from the City of Swan on 18 September 2009.”

The Brook is programmed to open in September 2010.
