An authorised witness for a statutory declaration that is **made at a place in Western Australia** —

- (a) Academic (post-secondary institution), Accountant, Architect, Australian Consular Officer, Australian Diplomatic Officer, Bailiff, Bank Manager, Chartered Secretary, Chemist, Chiropractor, Company Auditor or Liquidator, Court Officer, Defence Force Officer, Dentist, Doctor, Electorate Officer of a Member of State Parliament, Engineer, Industrial Organisation Secretary, Insurance Broker, Justice of the Peace, Landgate Officer, Lawyer, Local Government CEO or Deputy CEO, Local Government Councillor, Loss Adjuster, Marriage Celebrant, Member of Parliament, Minister of Religion, Nurse, Optometrist, Patent Attorney, Physiotherapist, Police Officer, Post Office Manager, Psychologist, Public Notary, Public Servant (Commonwealth), Public Servant (State), Real Estate Agent, Settlement Agent, Sheriff or Deputy Sheriff, Surveyor, Registered Teacher, Tribunal Officer, Veterinary Surgeon or any other person under schedule 2 of the Act; or
- (b) A person before whom, under the *Statutory Declarations Act 1959 (Cth)*, a statutory declaration may be made.

An authorised witness for a statutory declaration that is **made at a place outside Western Australia but within Australia** —

- (a) any person who, under the law of that place, has authority to take or receive a statutory, solemn or other declaration; or
- (b) any person before whom, under the *Statutory Declarations Act 1959 (Cth)*, a statutory declaration may be made.

An authorised witness for a statutory declaration that is **made at any other place** —

- (a) a prescribed consular official who is performing official functions at that place;
- (b) a person who is a justice or notary public under the law of that place;
- (c) a person who has authority under the law of that place to administer an oath to another person or to take, receive or witness a statutory, solemn or other declaration.
