Important Information

Should you pay for the personal or business rate?

The account for certain types of vehicles requires the owner to choose between personal and business rate payment options.

If the wrong rate is paid, and this vehicle is involved in an accident that results in a claim for personal injury by a third party, then you, as the owner described in the vehicle licence issued herewith, may be in breach of the insurance policy. This may then result in a recovery action by the Insurance Commission of Western Australia, against you, for the costs of settling that personal injury claim, in accordance with the Motor Vehicle (Third Party Insurance) Act 1943.

Business rate

Whether you licence your vehicle at the personal rate or at the business rate impacts the amount of Compulsory Third Party Insurance (CTPI) you pay.

You must pay the business rate if your vehicle:

- Is used for business purposes; and/or
- You or your business are registered for GST and entitled to claim an Input Tax Credit (ITC) for the CTPI component of the licence.

Personal rate

v10 DOT #01

To be eligible for the personal rate your vehicle must be a car or motorcycle that is licensed in the name of a natural person and not used for business purposes.

Selling or Buying a Vehicle

When a vehicle is sold, both the seller and the purchaser are required to notify the Director General by completing a Notification of Change of Ownership form (MR9). These are available online at www.transport.wa.gov.au/dvs

The vehicle should not be driven while subject to Department of the Attorney General enforcement action.

Change of address

If you have changed your address, you must notify the Department of Transport in writing within 21 days. Notification of change of address can be completed online at www.transport.wa.gov.au/dvs or alternatively the details may be faxed to 1300 669 995. Please provide your full name, date of birth, previous & current address, drivers licence number and all vehicle plate numbers (including trailers, motorcycles, caravans, and boats licensed in your name).

Return of Plates

If you do not renew this vehicle licence, you must return the number plates to the Department of Transport within three months of the current expiry date to avoid any penalty.

Pensioner Concession Information

If you hold a Pensioner Concession Card or both a Commonwealth Seniors Health Card and WA Seniors Card, you may be eligible for a concession on your vehicle licence fee. For further information on concession entitlements visit www.transport.wa.gov.au/dvs or call 13 11 56.

Concession entitlements must be applied for prior to the payment of the vehicle licence renewal otherwise full payment is required.

If you currently receive a concession on your vehicle licence fees and your eligibility entitlements have changed, you must notify the Department of Transport immediately. If you continue to claim concession rates on a vehicle, and you are no longer entitled to that concession, the vehicle licence will be deemed invalid. The continued use of the vehicle on any road will be in contravention of the Road Traffic Act 1974.

Insurance Policy – Issued under the Motor Vehicle (Third Party Insurance) Act 1943

The Insurance Commission of Western Australia, subject to the warranties and conditions contained in this policy and to the provisions of the Motor Vehicle (Third Party Insurance) Act 1943, in this policy referred to as "the Act", agrees to insure the owner of the motor vehicle described in the vehicle licence issued herewith and any other person who drives that motor vehicle, whether with or without the consent of the owner, in respect of all liability for negligence which may be incurred by the owner or other person in respect of the death of or bodily injury to any person directly caused by, or by the driving of, that motor vehicle in any part of the Commonwealth during the period from the date of the issue of this policy to the date of expiry of the said Traffic licence.

Warranties

The owner warrants that the vehicle will not be (a) Used for any other purpose than that stated by the owner in his/her

- application for this policy;
- (b) Driven in an unsafe or damaged condition;
- (c) Driven by or in charge of himself/herself or any other person who is unlicensed to drive or who is under the influence of intoxicating liquor.

It shall be a defence to any action in respect of the warranty contained in subclause (c) if the owner proves that the vehicle was so driven or in charge of such other person without his knowledge or consent.

Conditions

- The owner and any other person claiming indemnity under this policy shall comply with the provisions of Sections 10 and 11 of the Act. Sections 7 (5) and 15 of the Act are deemed to be incorporated in this
- insurance.
- The Commission is entitled to all rights remedies and benefits which 3 may accrue to it by virtue of the Act.

- (A) This policy does not extend to liability for third party property damage. You are advised to consult your normal insurance company for details.
- (B) Off-road vehicles: vehicles registered for off-road use are to comply with and be used in accordance with the provisions of the Control of Vehicles (Off-Road Areas) Act 1978.
- (C) Third party insurance policy does not apply to vehicles registered for off-road use.
- (D) Third party insurance cover extends to 15 days after the expiry of the licence provided renewal is effected within 15 days of the expiry.
