Objectives

All sponsorship requests are assessed according to the criteria below. Please ensure your sponsorship proposal addresses the relevant criteria.

Criteria

1. Provides research into the treatment of industrial diseases, or;
2. Provides research into the treatment of personal injury, or;
3. Provides research, education or promotion about the prevention of industrial diseases, or;
4. Provides research, education or promotion about the prevention of personal injury, or;
5. Provides research, education or promotion about the prevention of accidental death, and;
6. Is based in Western Australia with outcomes delivered locally, and;
7. Aligns with the Insurance Commission's objectives, priorities and funding decisions.
