The Catastrophic Injuries Support Scheme Dispute Resolution Expert Review Panel



The Insurance Commission of Western Australia (Insurance Commission) provides motor injury insurance for owners and drivers of registered vehicles in Western Australia.

The Insurance Commission administers the Catastrophic Injuries Support Scheme (CISS) that provides lifetime treatment, care and support for people catastrophically injured in motor vehicle crashes in Western Australia.

If an injured person does not agree about a decision on their CISS eligibility or the treatment they receive, they can first discuss this with the Insurance Commission.

If disputes cannot be resolved directly with the Insurance Commission, the person raising the dispute can request it be referred for review by an Expert Review Panel (ERP).

An ERP is convened by the Convenor and comprises of medical experts and allied health professionals who are registered under the Health Practitioner Regulation National Law (WA).

The Convenor, Deputy Convenor and Medical Experts are appointed by the Minister.

The list of Medical Experts is required to be published under section 52 of the Motor Vehicle (Catastrophic Injuries) Regulations 2016.
