

CLAIMS

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You may be able to make an injury insurance claim if you are injured in a crash.

You can do this by calling the Insurance Commission on +61(8) 9264 3333.

If your injuries are relatively minor and you need medical bills paid, we can do this quickly. You'll need to provide us with a copy of the bills and/or receipts for payment or reimbursement. We can also give you a reference number so your treating providers can send accounts directly to us. The majority of claims we receive are for minor injuries.

For more severe or long-lasting injuries, you will need to lodge a claim by completing a Notice of Intention to Claim and Medical Authority form. [Contact us](#) for these forms and once complete, your claim can be assessed.
